Looking back:


The first wave of SHARE data collection in 2004

- ightharpoonup April − October 2004: Main field period of first wave in 10 countries \Rightarrow 22,777 interviews (Release 1)
- ➤ April 2005: SHARE Launch in Brussels ⇒ Publication of 'First Results' book (~ 3,000 copies distributed so far)
- > September 2005: First SHARE-ELSA-HRS User Conference, Lund, Sweden
- ➤ June 2006: More than 20 registered publications (incl. articles in *European Journal of Public Health*, *Health Economics*, *Journal of Marriage and Family*) & 400 registered users ...

Looking ahead:

Wave 1 (cont'd.) & preparing for Wave 2

- > (Very) late 2006: Release 2 of SHARE 2004, incl. ...
- ... data from Belgium & Israel,
- ... additional observations from 'vignettes samples',
- ... improved imputations of income & wealth variables,
- ... further variables (ISCO, regional identifiers, etc.)
- ➤ From Spring 2005: Proposals for continuation of SHARE ⇒ European Union (SHARE-I3, COMPARE, SHARELIFE) & U.S. National Institute on Aging (IAG) ...





Looking ahead:

New features in SHARE 2006 (Wave 2)

- ➤ Prospective time dimension: measuring continuity & change in people's life (and death) ...
- > Additional health dimensions: peak flow measure & chair stand test ...
- Expanding geographically:
- ... inclusion of the new central European member states Czech Republic & Poland, plus Ireland!
- ... cooperation with Korean & Japanese ageing surveys!
- ... improving the integration of ELSA & SHARE databases!





Current state of Wave 2 & future steps

- ➤ May June 2006: (Longitudinal) pretest in all countries (postponed in Ireland)
- ➤ September 2006 May 2007: Field period of Wave 2 (baseline wave in CZ & PL; later start in Ireland)
- > January 2007: Official start of SHARELIFE project -
- collection of retrospective life-histories (employment, family events, health) for full SHARE sample
- ... and finally: preparing for Wave 3!
